About the Author, Alison Wearing



Alison Wearing is the bestselling author of *Confessions of a Fairy's Daughter*, an Indigo Top 50 Pick shortlisted for the Edna Staebler Prize and longlisted for the RBC Taylor Prize and *Honey-moon in Purdah: An Iranian Journey*. She leads writing workshops internationally and online, and is also an award-winning performer of original solo plays. www.alisonwearing.com

Wearing was born in Peterborough, Ontario, in 1967. Her mother and father were both pianists and Wearing speaks of music as her "mother tongue".^[1] Wearing's father, Joseph Wearing, was also a professor of political studies at Trent University. Alison Wearing left high school in Canada to study French at the University of Nantes. She returned to Canada to study music at the University of Western Ontario, then political science at Wilfrid Laurier University and the University of Marburg, Germany.

Moments of Glad Grace a Memoir-Narrated by the Author

The story begins as a trip from Canada to Ireland in search of genealogical data and documents. Being 80 and in the early states of Parkinson's disease, Joe invites his daughter Alison to come along as his research assistant, which might have worked very well had she any interest-at all- in genealogy. Very quickly, the father-daughter pilgrimage becomes more comical than fruitful, more of a bittersweet adventure than a studious mission. And rather than rigorous genealogy, their explorations move into the realm of family and forgiveness, the primal search for identify and belonging, and questions about responsibility to our ancestors and the extent to which we are shaped by the people who come before us. Though continually bursting with humor, *Moments of Glad Grace* is a story about identity, history, and ultimately becomes a song of appreciation for the precious and limited time we have with our parents.
